

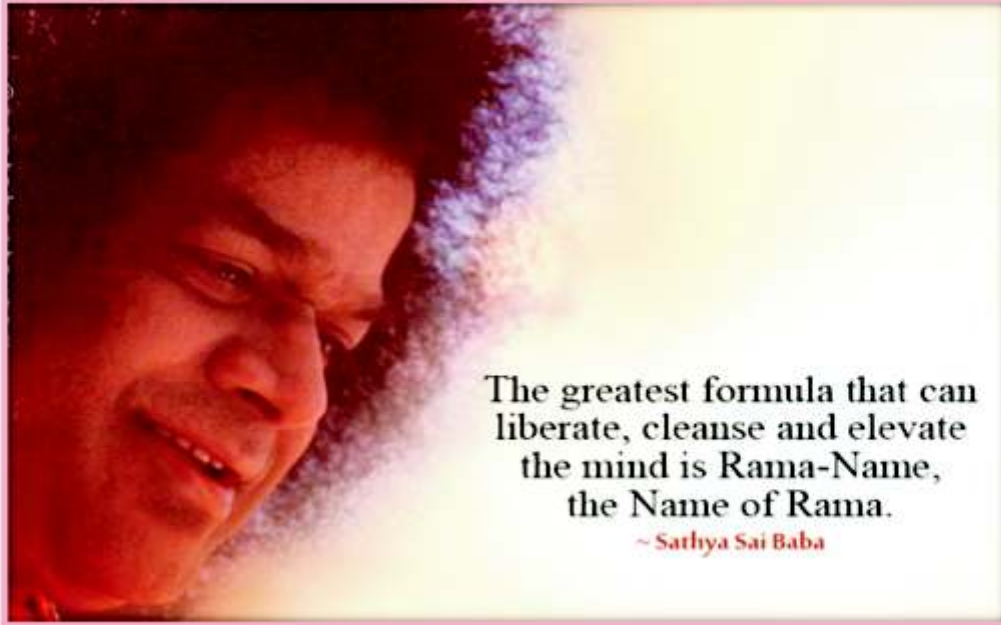

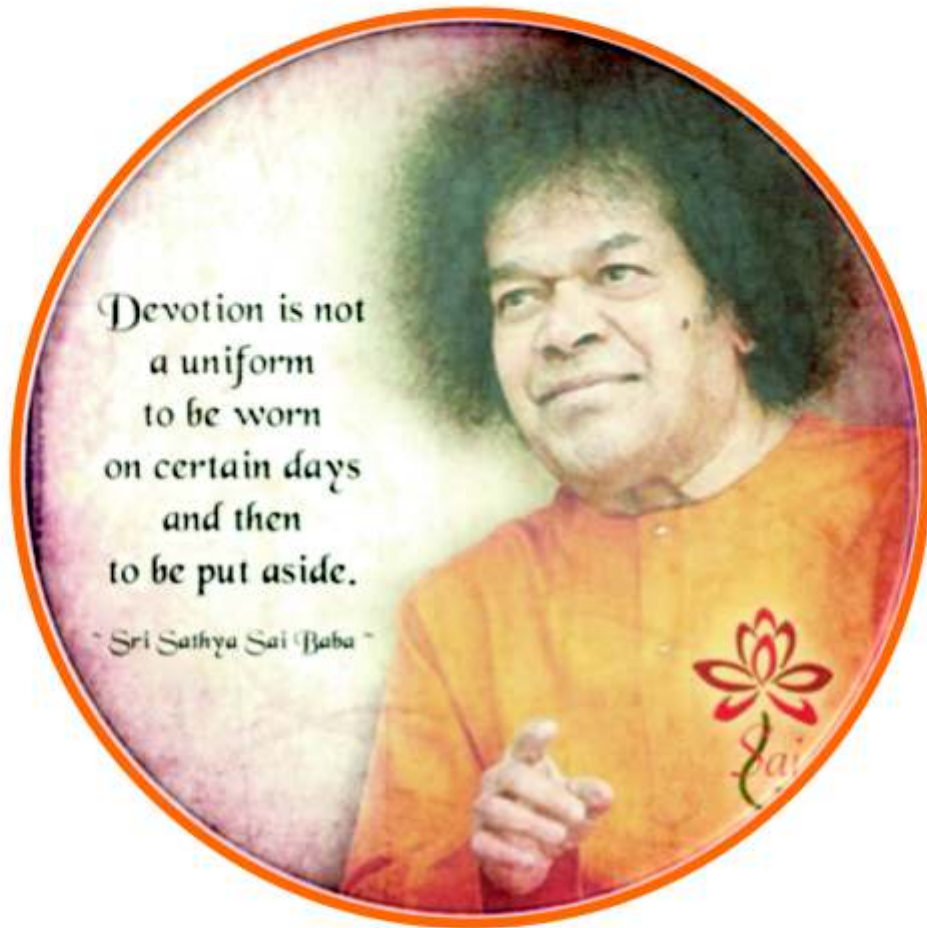

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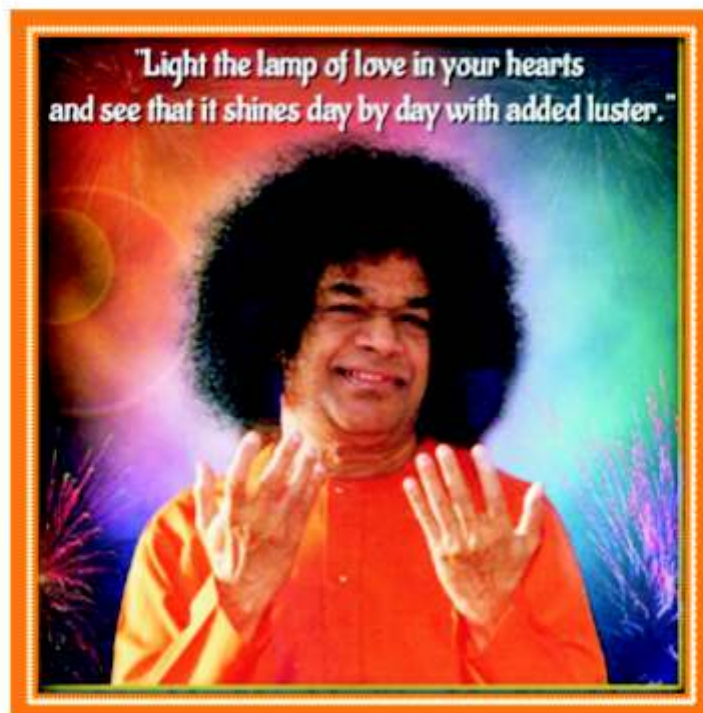

From the desk of Academic Administator

Om Sri Sai Ram,

I offer my humble pranam at the Lotus Feet of Sri Sathya Sai Baba and pray for grace and showering his blessing to complete 2017-18 academic session successfully.

The annual report of the 2017-18 academic session is a window of the school academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities carried out by the students during the past academic session. It gives informations about activities undertaken by the students during the Science fair exhibition, Maths fair exhibition, Hindi Week and the Annual Sports day. The photographs of the various activities performed during these events are presented for the viewers to assess the impact of learning subjects through experimental demonstration and model making. The students also acquire communicative and hand skills and understand the basic concept of scientific subjects as well as their applications in everyday life. The Hindi week offers them to demonstrate language skill through writing poems, essays writing and oration. The drawing exhibition demonstrates their art concept and skills. The photographs of the annual sport day gives ideas about sports, games, Karate, Yoga and dancing activities undertaken during the year. The students also participate in national events like 15th August Independence Day, 26th January Republic Day celebration within the campus while Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated outside the campus at Navsari near Gandhiji's Statue by organizing Swacchhta Abhiyan. The participation in games, sports and athletic events leading to physical activities help the students to remain stress free, an important aspect of learning process. The school has two large play ground one for the boys and one for the girls to practice outdoor games and sports. The students practice indoor games in the large auditorium in the campus. Our school also organize excursion trips to study Science centres, cultural and heritage place etc. Our students also participate in games and athletic events at Taluka level, District level, State level and National level events and have won prizes. All these events provide excellent platform to our students to show case their creative, debating and hand on skills. The participation in these events help student to develop pleasant personality, self confidence and self esteem, self discipline, character building, sportsman ship and the mental, physical and emotional well being to face future challenges of life. Also the co-scholastic activities help to break down barrier among students and foster friendship and brotherhood.

Sathya Sai Vidyaniketan is one of the Unique school different from the private and government grant in aid schools that the school follows Sri Sathya Sai Baba's philosophy of Educare, means the education system offering healthy balance between the academic excellence and the human value excellence. The knowledge of academic speciality subject is necessary for earning lively hood for living but the later is necessary for a successful journey through life. We need to rediscover ancient education in relation to human values.

Every session the school is organizing parents awareness programme for the parents of each class to give information about the core value of the academic programme, their co-operation for the shake of their children, cultivation of good manners and social behaviour and conclusive home environment for healthy growth of children. Our school adopted participators teaching and learning process, put in practice through question – answer session. Project work and discussion. The project works encourage creative and critical thinking and self learning process while through the question – answer and discussion student's acquire communication and expressive skills and boost self confidence and self esteem.

The following quotes of Sri Sathya Sai Baba are valid with respect to the present secular education system in our country.

- (i) The academic degrees without character is of no value other than earning for living.
- (ii) The knowledge is power but if it is without self discipline and self control, compassion and sympathy does more harm than good.

- 33 (Science Stream) and 8 (Commerce Stream) students appeared for higher secondary examination (AISSCE) 2018 and passed out with high distinction and pass percentage was 98%.
- In different External Exam our students took one step forward and qualified for second level. Some External Exams are –

CO-Curricular activities

In our school we undertake co-curricular activities every Saturday, except during exams. This is to bring out the hidden talent of the students along with the academics. 

AUM SRI SAI RAM REPORT OF BALVIKAS SUBJECT

Our school provides physical, intellectual and emotional growth of the child but Sri Satya Sai Balvikas programme provides all-round development of the child so that he can face the challenges in life with dignity, confidence and strong character. Sri Sathya Sai Balvikas aims at inculcating good habits in the child so that he grows up into an ideal citizen – an asset not only to his parents but to the society, nation, and world at large.

It is conducted every Monday, in the first period for one hour by the class teachers in their respective classes through the use of five teaching techniques- Silent sitting/guided visualization, story telling, prayers, group singing and group activities. This course commences with small children (Group I) between 6 and 9 years of age for creating interest in the child's mind, for the collective discipline and instruction that is to follow when the child moves on to Group II between the age 9 and 12 years and 13 to 15 years. When the students come in eighth standard they have to appear for the Balvikas exam. It is conducted under the supervision of the concerned Education Coordinators and Balvikas Gurus. The Question paper for the examination is given the State Education Coordinator. The record of the students appeared for the exams since 2008 is filed with their marks.

During 5-6 years of this training, the child is expected to have derived the following benefits.

1. Having due respect for parents and other elders at home.
2. Pay due attention to school studies and respect to the school teachers.
3. Show good physical orderliness in respect of dress, behavior in school, society etc.
4. Develop good moral character.
5. Develop self-confidence.
6. Develop good manners, humility and speaking obligingly.
7. Make good use of time by planning it in a balanced way between play, study, prayers etc.
8. Have spirit of service for the needy people.
9. Have true love for God who expects us to be truthful, honest, good, loving, kind and helpful to all fellow beings.
10. Be a disciplined child.

The objectives of Sri Satya Sai Balvikas is to initiate the child into a course of character building by developing self-discipline, providing healthy association, inculcating such habits of reading, listening, studying and reciting the shlokas and value based songs and prayers.

Balvikas Gurus are trained as per the guidelines issued by the All India President, Sri Sathya Sai Organizations, India.

Life insurance or life assurance, especially in the commonwealth of nation is a contract between insurance policy holder and an insurer or assurer, where the insurer promises to pay a designated beneficiary a sum of money (the benefit) in exchange for a premium, upon the death of an insured person often the policy holder.

Life policies are legal contracts and the terms of the contracts describe the limitations of the insured events. Specific exclusions are often written into the contract to limit the liability of the insurer.

For the first two years (i.e., up to Std. 2), the children would study in a separate wing of the Trusts existing school, "Sri Sathya Sai Vidyaniketan, with an aim to create a strong foundation and to prepare them to enter the main stream school from Std. 3 onwards. Thus, from Std. 3, they will be able to study along with all other students of Sri Sathya Sai Vidyaniketan. Further, Sri Sai Seva Charitable Trust takes complete responsibility till they graduate or finish vocational training and become self-reliant.



To keep them healthy and hearty, many indoor and outdoor activities are conducted from 1:00 P.M. to 4:30 P.M. The art and craft, video presentation, recreational activities and games and sports keep them in the mainstream of value based education which helps them to enhance their holistic development.

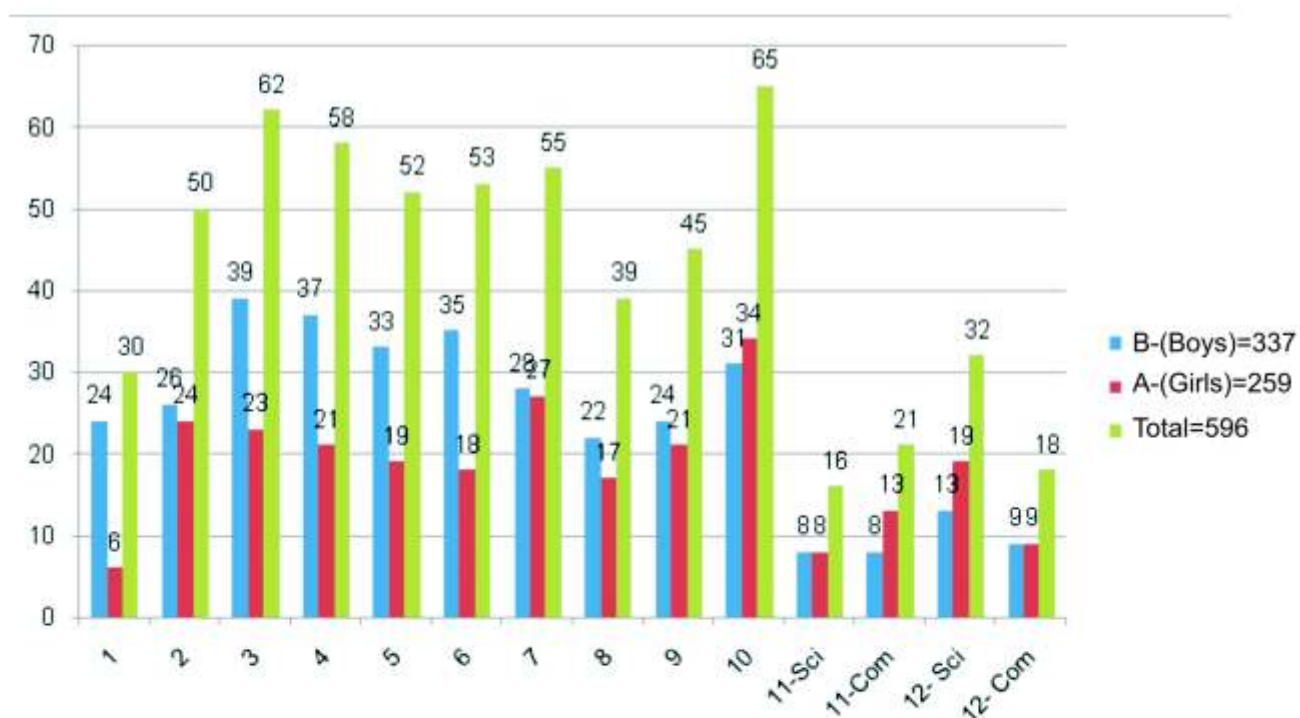

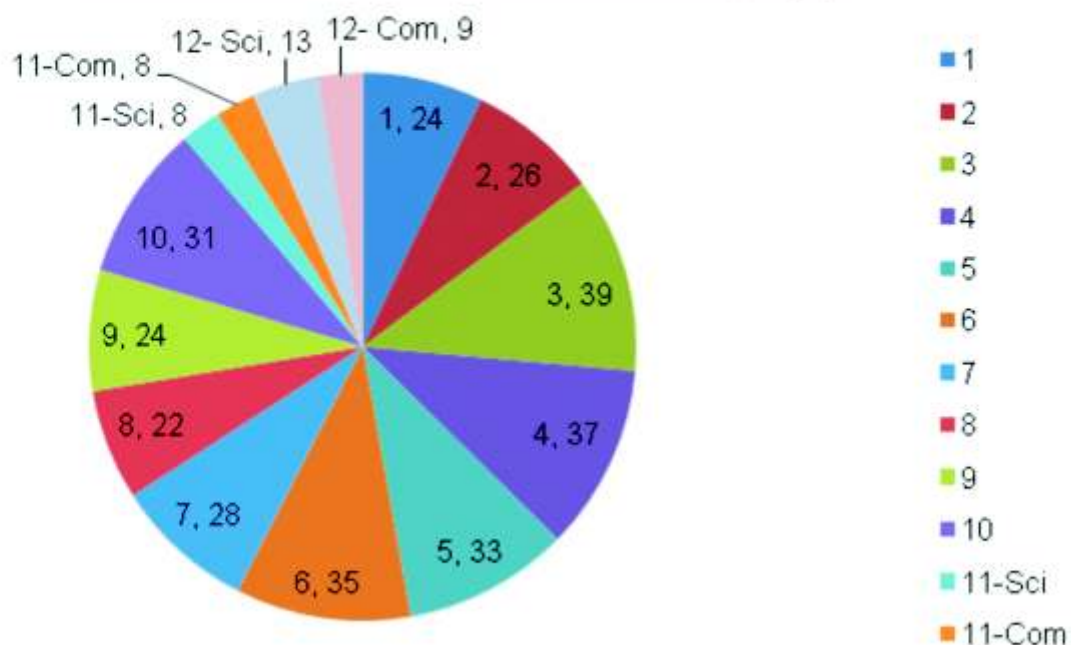

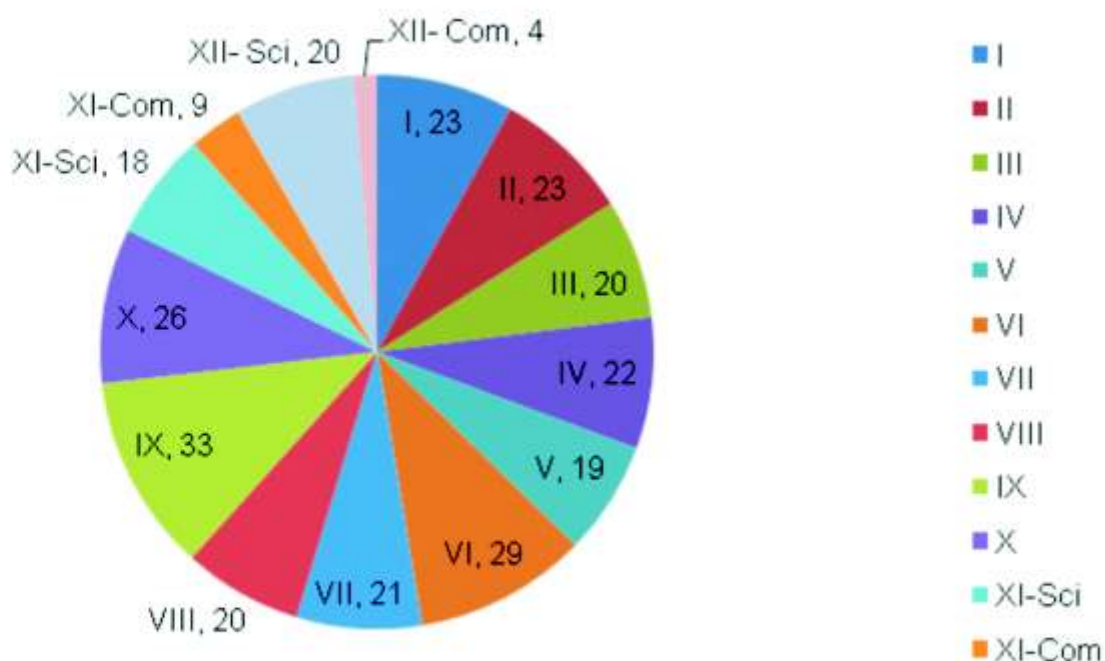
